

Ashby RFC - opportunities for all ages and abilities

Our Age Grade Rugby section covers year groups 1 to 13, with each playing level being age appropriate. Our Under 7s and Under 8s play tag rugby, with contact being introduced in phases from Under 9s onwards. We have dedicated Girls teams for Under 12s, 14s, 16s and 18s. We have also secured funding to promote and support direct entry for U12 girls wishing to experience and enjoy rugby.

Sporting approximately 220 young players, boys and girls, across all age groups, we have plenty of opportunity for kids to access rugby at a grass roots level. Our "Rugby Offering" mirrors the principles of the RFU, ensuring that we focus on Teamwork, Respect, Enjoyment, Discipline and Sportsmanship. At our heart is a desire to be a community asset that provides our players, parents and supporters with a safe, supportive and enjoyable rugby experience.

We're currently looking to flood our ranks with new players and are looking for support from our local schools. Some of your parents may have visited us during the School Tag festivals or County Cup Fixtures. I've included an electronic flyer that I'd very much appreciate if you could circulate.

To support this drive, we are offering the first 4 weeks for free, allowing new members the opportunity to fall in love with the game prior to signing up to the Club. For younger kids (or those with fast growing feet), we have 'boot exchange' so parents can swap footwear. A thrift shop is also available to assist those during these times of financial hardship. Discounts are available for siblings and playing tops are provided with each game. Games are played on Sundays (except for the Academy/U18s who play on Saturdays) - typically between 09:00 - 13:00 depending on the age group.

All of our Coaches are DBS checked, have completed the necessary Player Welfare

Qualifications (Headcase, Safeguarding, TackleSafe) and hold applicable Age Grade Coaching Qualifications. During a recent membership survey, our coaches were identified as one of the biggest assets to Ashby RFC. All Ashby RFC coaches have a desire to deliver active, enjoyable and safe sessions which enable children to enjoy the sport.

To further our objective of providing additional community value, we have a number of qualified coaches who are available to assist your teachers with any school rugby sessions, or to deliver a 'guest' training session to your pupils. If you'd like me to facilitate attendance at one of these sessions, please let me know and we'll get a date booked in.

Leicestershire County Cricket Club Running Foxes Winter Coaching Programme 2022/2023

Following the successful running of last year's winter coaching programme, Leicestershire County Cricket Club will once again be running a winter coaching programme this coming winter. The Running Foxes Winter Coaching Programme is designed to offer boys and girls across Leicestershire and Rutland 18-weeks of coaching to help fulfil their individual potential by offering a winter programme that complements their club cricket. The programme involves weekly hard ball cricket sessions at training centres across the county for U11, U13, U15 and U19 age groups and will run across the winter from November 2022– March 2023. The aim of the winter programme is to provide coaching to players of all abilities throughout the winter and allow them to perform more consistently by having set targets based upon Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) deemed appropriate for each age group. More information about the programme, the process and costs are included in the attached information sheet.

Please could you forward this onto any parents and players that you think might be interested in taking part in this programme and improving their cricket. Please note that by attending the Running Foxes Winter Coaching Programme players will not

automatically be nominated to attend trials for the respective Boys or County Age Group Programmes. Nominations for these trials will be sent separately to clubs asking to nominate players they feel may meet the required standard for these programmes.

All players that are interested in taking part in the winter coaching programme, please complete the expression of interest online form using the link below. will give us an indication of the number of players that would like to take part and allow us to allocate suitable venues and sessions to specific age groups to meet the needs of the group. Once we have this information, we will then send out details of the session that has been allocated to players, as in previous years, with a link to a booking and payment site.
