Staffing Update

Mrs Woodbridge-Stocks will be finishing for her maternity leave next Friday and after a full recruitment process we are pleased to share that Miss Arckless will be taking on the teaching of Class 2 full time until the end of the academic year in the first instance. We have recruited a new teaching assistant called Mrs Farron who will be joining us after half term and will join our teaching assistant team of Mrs Gill, Mrs Fizzell and Mrs Tivey who work across our classes. Mrs Heselton is also going to be providing some SENDCO support to another school during the rest of this academic year, in addition to her deputy head / SENDCO role here at St Hardulph's and the SENDCO role she undertakes for Belton Primary. As such, Mrs Edden our own regular supply teacher is going to be teaching Class 3 for one morning a week in Mrs Heselton's place. I am also continuing to undertake the seconded Executive Headteacher role at Moira Primary School and will continue to split my time between the two schools. As always, I am contactable regardless of which school I am at and should you need to get in touch with me, please do so by email or by contacting Mrs Russell in the school office who will arrange for me to contact you.

Safeguarding

Due to the staffing changes above, Miss Tyrer is now our named Designated Safeguarding Lead with Mrs Ellis, Mrs Heselton and Mrs Russell as our deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads. We are all trained to the same level and all manage our safeguarding responsibilities in school. Should you have any safeguarding concerns, please do make contact with one of us.

Bookings for Wrap-Around Care

Booking for After School Care 1 & 2 and for Breakfast Club need to be booked (& paid for) by 1pm of the Friday in advance of the following week as registers for the sessions are produced on Friday's for us to confirm staffing needs and order food etc.

As per our policy, children can attend breakfast club on the day. However after-school must be pre-booked and if you require after school care after the Friday booking deadline, you must contact the office to confirm a place for your child.

Year 6 Key Stage 2 SAT's Date Change

An additional bank holiday in honour of the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III will take place on Monday 8 May 2023. As this date had previously been announced as the first day of the 2023 key stage 2 (KS2) test week in England, a change to the KS2 test schedule next year will be necessary.

Ministers have considered the situation carefully and have decided that KS2 tests will take place in the same week with tests following the usual order but each taking place one day later than originally planned. As such, the new schedule will be:

- Tuesday 9 May: English grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) papers 1 (questions) and 2 (spelling)
- Wednesday 10 May: English reading paper
- Thursday 11 May: mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)
- Friday 12 May: mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)
